*Writing a One World Reflection: **Middle School Planning Guide***

What is an issue or place I care about?

This question addresses the “what” and “where” of your Reflection. If you are writing about another culture, where is it and what it is like? If it is a global issue, how does it impact you and other teenagers?

What connects you personally to the topic?

A One World Reflection is not a report, so you must have a relationship to your topic. Alexandra writes about her experiences with bullying and Lucas writes about his brother’s struggle with autism.

What information do I know and need to research?

Although your One World Reflection is based on a personal experience, you must include information so others can get a full understanding of the topic. This may involve some research. If you are writing about homelessness, you should share statistics about homelessness in your city and/or country in addition to your personal experience.
