One World Education & the Challenge

One World Education's mission is to transform students into writers with voice, knowledge, and purpose. One World serves 5,000 middle school, high school, and adult learners annually at 20-25 DC schools through in-school and afterschool programs.

One World's afterschool program, the One World Academy, helps middle and high school students improve their research and writing skills so they are ready for high school, college, and beyond. Students work with One World's highest-performing teachers and mentors in an afterschool experience that is relevant, supportive, and challenging. This year, One World launched its first "Academy Hub" at Friendship SE PCS, serving students who might otherwise not enjoy access to afterschool programming. In tonight's showcase, students from both academies will present their social justice research findings and solutions to their communities while competing for scholarship awards.


